



Situate on the west side of French creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c Resurveyed the 10th July 1799 In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres granted to Peter S DuPonceace Bearing date the 30th May 1792 It being the same tract which was Surveyed the ~~30~~ 28th October 1797 for Hugh McAllastur for^{on} his improvement dated 27th Oct. 1797.

I do certify that the above is a true copy of a survey as it stands stated of record remaining in my office Now situate in Followfield township Crawford County Excepting the line of division which was surveyed & marked between Joseph Clark & John Jackson the fifth day of July 1817.
