Originally Surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 20th day of September 1785 for George Harris in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Davis bearing date the 18th day of November 1756 Resurveyed and divided Off from the said larger Tract on the 17th day of October 1813 by Issac Kirk D.S. under Jacob Spangler late D.S. and now at the request of the present owner James Rowell the same has been calculated examined and found to be correct and at his request return the same for confirmation October 6th A. D. 1819.
