



Draft of a tract of land situate in Frenchcreek township Venango County west of the Allegheny river, on Sandy creek containing four hundred acres and allowance; Adjoining lands settled by James Nicholson on the south, James Brannon on the north, Robert Heynor on the west, and vacant land on the east. Surveyed 30th October 1818 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Dewoody, dated the third of August 1818. John Dewoody is now residing on the tract.
