



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the Two Mile Run in Washington County Called the Mill Valley Containing 305 1/4 Acres & 74 perches with the ~~usual allowance~~. Surveyed for Joseph Woodfield March the 9th 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate of which the following is a Copy.

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Yohogany & Ohio do hereby Certify that Joseph Woodfield is entitled to Four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Monongahela on two Mile Run to include his Actual Settlement made in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy four, and a Right of Preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining there to. Given under our hands at Redstone Old fort the twenty second Day of December 1779 in the fourth Year of the Common Wealth.
