That was Surveyed unto John Deal in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated at Philadelphia on the 19th Day of September Anno 1765. Notand: The Reason, That the Quantity of acres so far exceeds the Warrant is this. That the said John Deal Several years ago, had got the Said Land Surveyed to him and therefore was now accordingly resurveyed to the old Lines.
