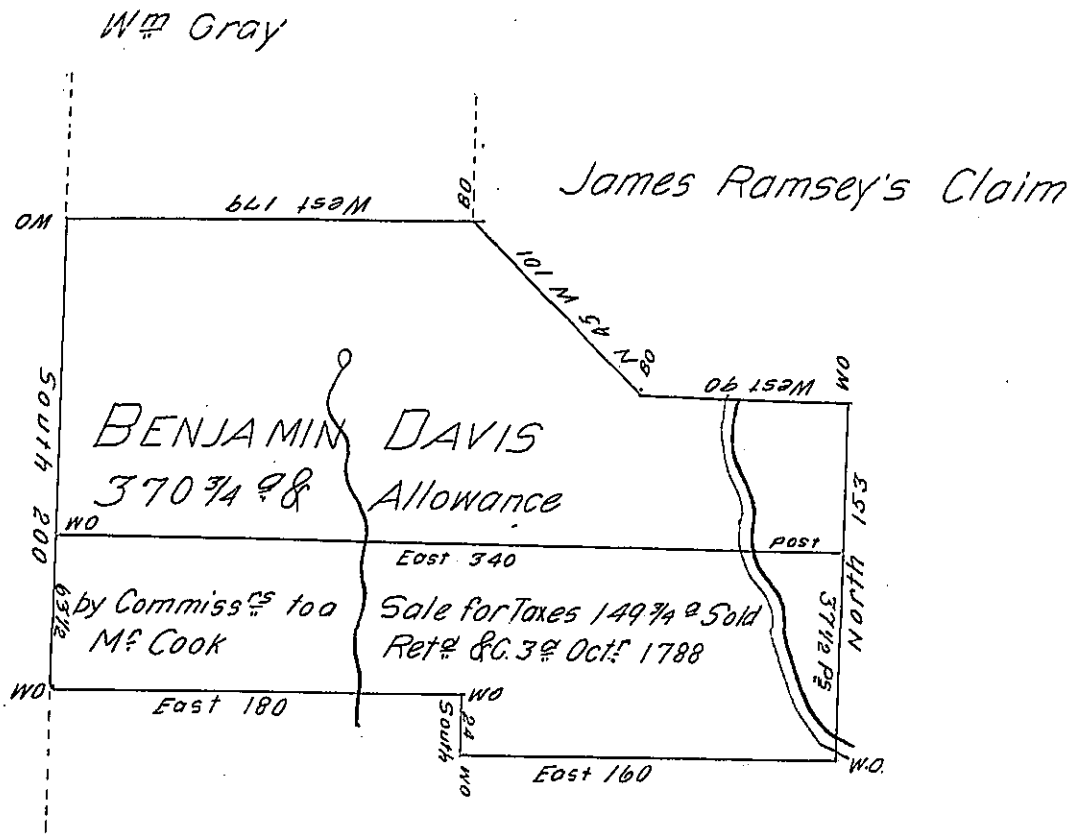

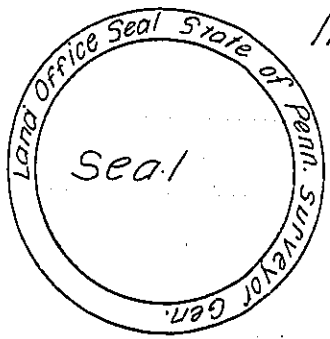


James Wilkey's Improvement
