



The above is a draught of a Survey made the 28th day of August Anno domini 1794 in pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners appointed by the State of Virginia to settle the claims of unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahaly, Yohogany and Ohio to John Hitch, assignee of John Vooch which Certificate I find entered with Robert Woods Surveyor of Ohio County on the 8th day of June Anno domini 1780 Situated on the waters of Wheeling Creek in the County of Washington Containing three hundred and eighty Acres ~~one Road and twenty~~ ^{SIX} eight perches Strict measure.
