



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres of land granted Henry Drinker dated the 14th day of April 1792, was surveyed the nineteenth day of April 1831, the above described tract of land, containing Four hundred and one acres & one hundred and fifty perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. situate in Summerhill township, Crawford County (being the same tract which was surveyed on the 12th day of May 1795 for James (obl.) Dur. in pursuance of his improvement, dated the 11th day of May 1795.)
