 Containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of 6 per Cent  
 for roads &c. Resurveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1799. In pursuance of a  
 Warrant for 400 acres granted to George Donacher bearing date  
 the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792. [ It being the same tract of land which was  
 surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> Nov. 1794 for John Dunwoody on his Improve-  
 ment dated 3<sup>d</sup> Nov. 1794.
