



Situate on the West side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of 6 per Ct for roads &c. Resurveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> July 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres granted to Abraham Dubois bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792. It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1795 for James Thomas on his Improvement dated 1<sup>st</sup> June 1795.
