



A Draught of a Tract of land Situate in Windsor Township in The County of York Originally Surveyed for Philip Decker by William Kersey and now Divided & Laid off for the said Philip In Pursuance of his Warrant Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1791 Containing one Hundred and Twenty one Acres and one Hundred and Thirty Nine perches and Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads & C.

N.B. the Part where the letter A Stands Separated by a Dotted line Contains 23 Acres and is Marked Returned by William Kersey for Detirick Wallack in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted Richard Howe & John Elliot the 9<sup>th</sup> April 1788. But in Pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property of the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of April 1793 And Agreeably thereto I have Annexed the above mentioned Twenty Three Acres to Deckers Warrant above mentioned Containing in the Whole as is above Set forth March 13<sup>th</sup> 1797.
