



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 12<sup>th</sup> day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Denniston for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth Day of February 1794 Adjoining Charles Campbell to the Eastward and on the North Side of the Conaquenesing Creek North & West of Ohio River Called Nabob Containing four Hundred and Nineteen Acres together With the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads
