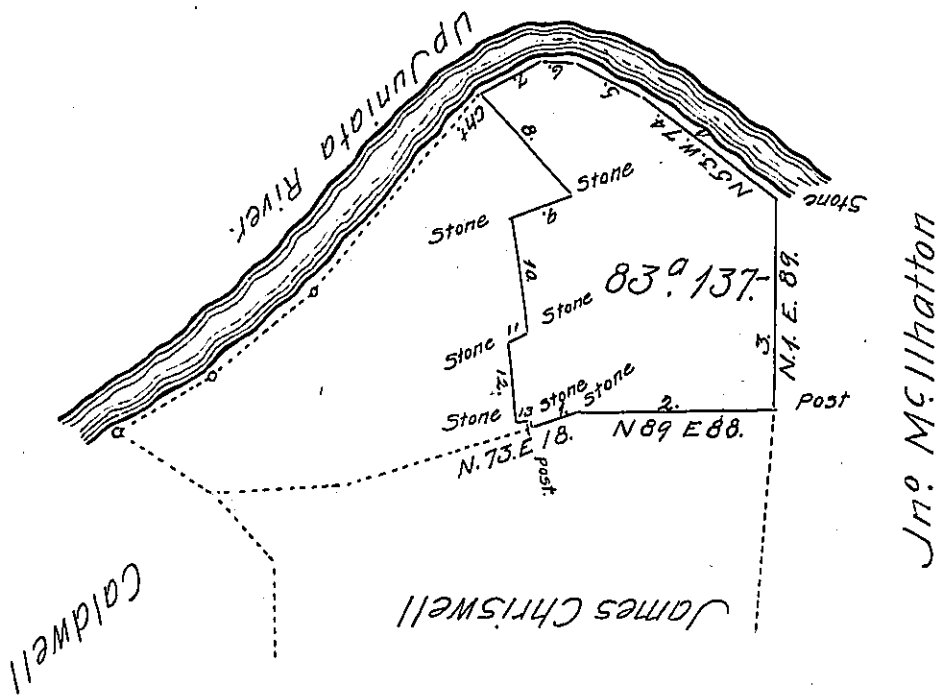

Resurveyed and divided 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> February AD. 1814. and found to contain 174 acres & 68 perches with 6 Pr Cent*
