



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 25th Day of May Anno-1749. granted to Michael Fisher The above described Tract of Land, Situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania.

Containing One Hundred and Seventy Two Acres and 8 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, was Surveyed for Jacob Fisher on the 16th Day of October Anno-1753. - [who Sold the said Place some Time after to Michael Striby.]
