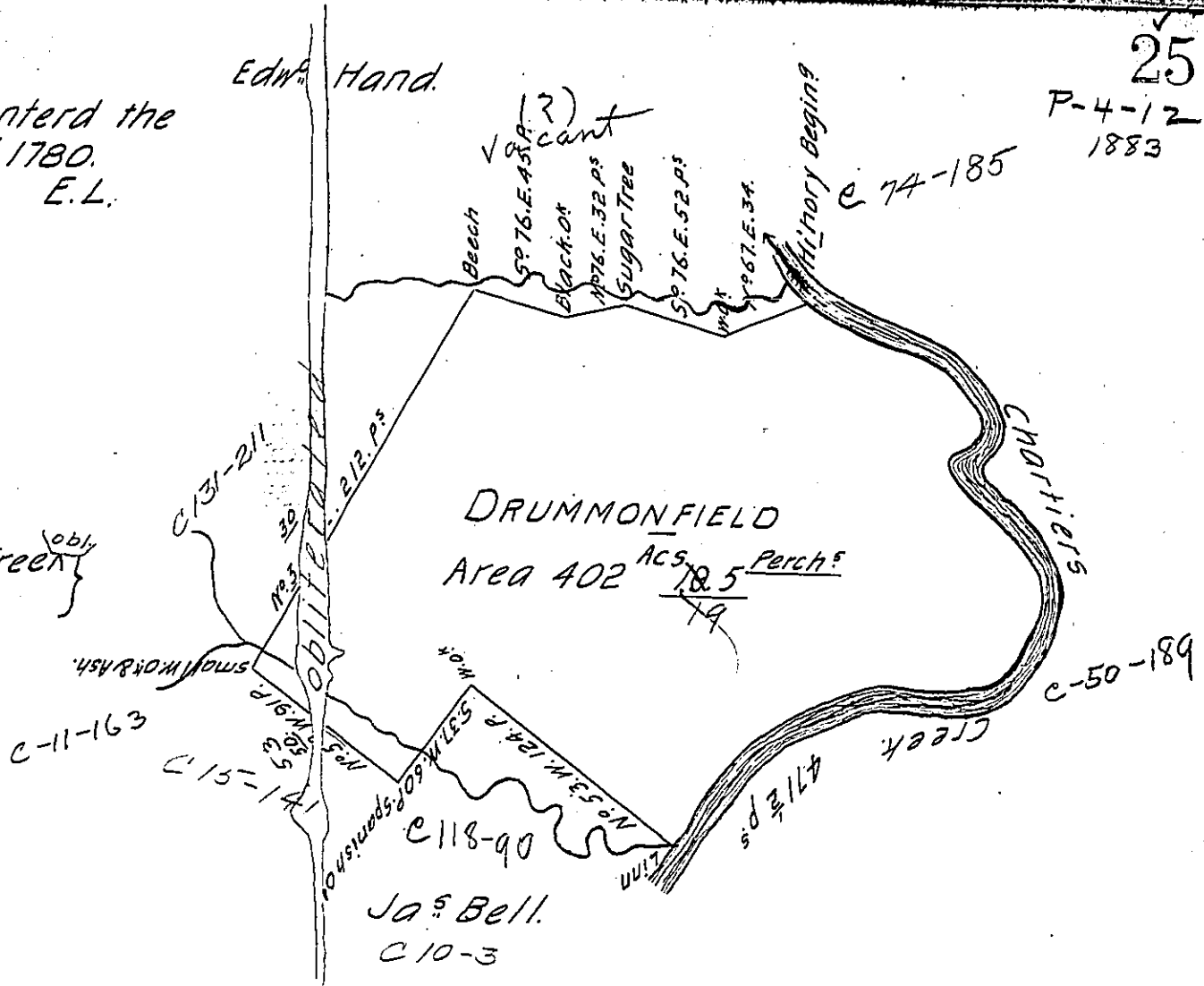

We the Commissioners ap-
pointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monoga-
li, Ohio and Yohogania do hereby Certify that William Drummond is Entitled to
four hundred Acres of Land in Yohogania County on Chartiers Creek, to inclu-
de his Settlement made in the year of Our Lord 1769, also a right of preemption
to one thous^d acres adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Coxes fort
the 17th febr^y 1780. in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
