Containing three hundred and one acre and three Quarters of an acre, besides the usual allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1795 for Nathaniel Falconer In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1793.
