



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1783, and by virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and seal of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup>, Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 1783. The above tract of land containing two hundred sixteen acres and one hundred and fifty six perches, was surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1785, by William Alexander, D.S.
