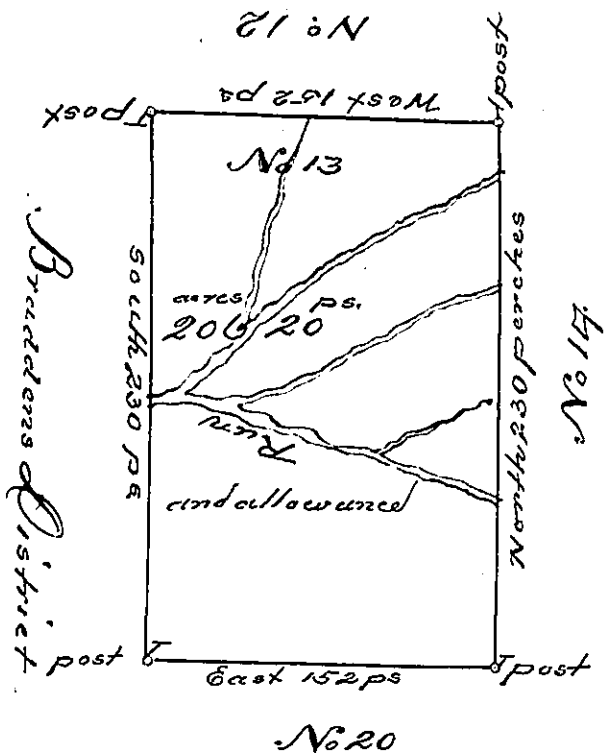


Part of District No 3.

Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. the above tract of land containing two hundred six acres and twenty perches and allowance of 6 ps. Cent for Roads. &c. Surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785, by
