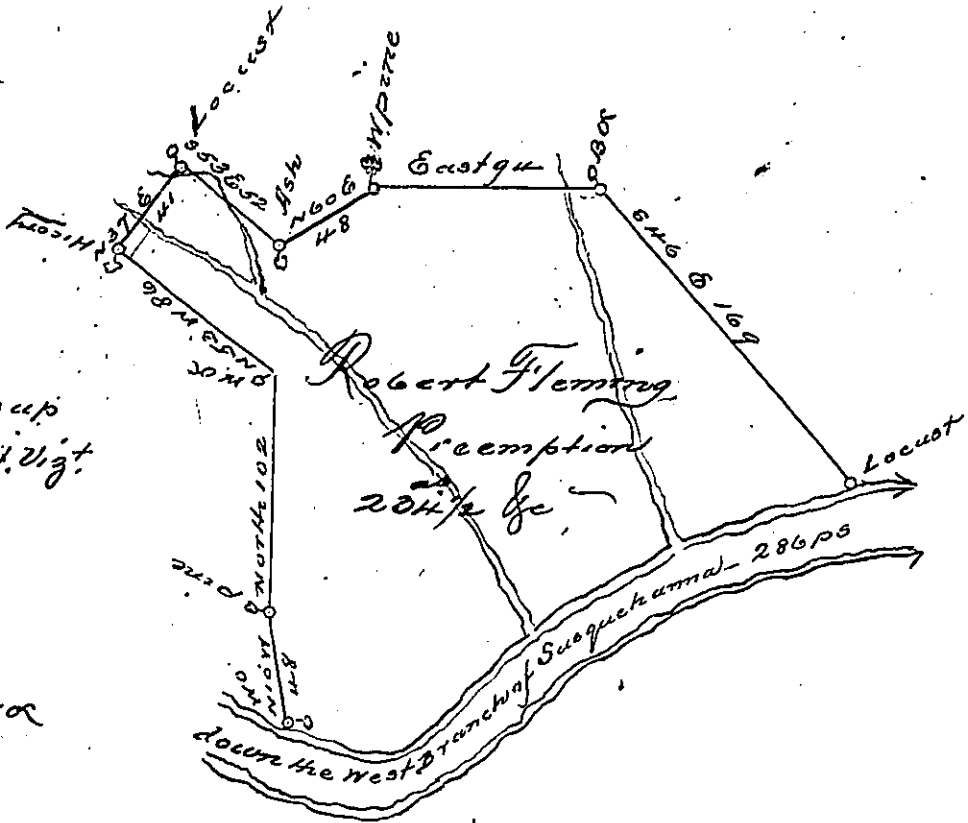

 the River from the Locust, Vizt.

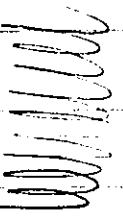

Situate on the North side of the West Branch of Susquehanna River & about two & an half Miles below the mouth of Sinnamahoning — formerly known by the name of Meginley's Bottom, containing Two hundred & thirty four & an half acres & the allowance of six P Cent
