



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Henry Clay and County of Fayette, containing thirty-two acres, sixty-nine perches and an allowance of six per cent. for roads etc. Constructed for Joseph Wolf the sixteenth day of October, 1901, it being part of a larger tract containing 272<sup>ac</sup> 11<sup>ps</sup> and allowance. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Corey Day dated the tenth day of February, 1794
