



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract of the same name situate between the Waters of Clearfield and Chest Creeks adjoining Land granted to Thomas Rodney Benjamin Betterton and Samuel Fisher about three Miles West of the upper (obl.) great Clearfield & 500 Perches Southward of that Part of Alexander Stuart's Tract at the Chest where the old Trading Path from Frankstown to the Kittanning crosses the first line of said Tract in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and four Acres & 110 Perches and the usual Allowance of six P Cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1773 for George Emlyn in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the same Year by
