Elder bearing date the 27th Day of Nov^r 1773 a Survey was made of the above described Tract of land containing Three hundred & Seventy one acob^s & allob^s of six P^{er} Cent for Roads &c^a Situate on the West side of the Monongahala River near adjoining Chartiers Creek, heretofore in the County of Westmoreland now in the County of Washington - Protracted & laid down from the field works of Alex^r McLean Dep^t Sur^v of Westmoreland County - Surveyed in Jan^y 1778
