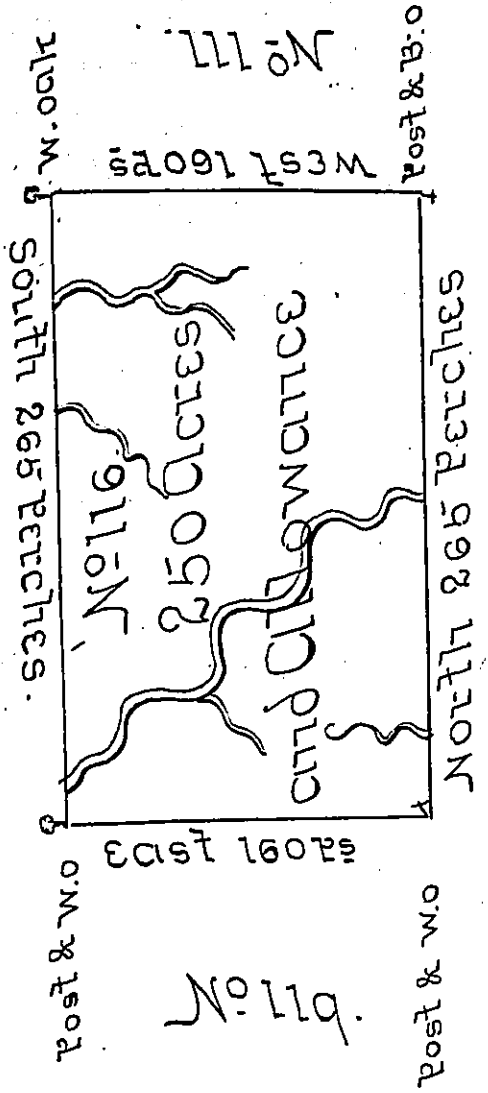

In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain lands therein mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1785. The Above tract of land containing two hundred and fifty Acres and Allowance was surveyed on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1785 by
