



The above described Tract of ten Acres and ninety three perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. is part of a larger tract of 19<sup>ac</sup> 68<sup>ps</sup> allowance situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) which was Surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> September 1785 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Eaton bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> Feby. 1775 Resurveyed and divided off for Isaac Eaton Esquire the 9<sup>th</sup> of November 1822.
