



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400^{acs} dated the 10th day of April 1793. Granted to David Elly was surveyed on the 19th day of August 1819 the annexed described tract of land containing four hundred eleven acres one hundred fifty nine Perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate in Casewago Township Crawford County on the waters of Big Coniout. And on the 12th Day of December 1826 having examined the same and found it to be Corect at which time Washington Sterling was Residing on the same with his family and had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appeared to be upwards of fifty acres of the land Cleared fenced & in a good state of Cultivation.
