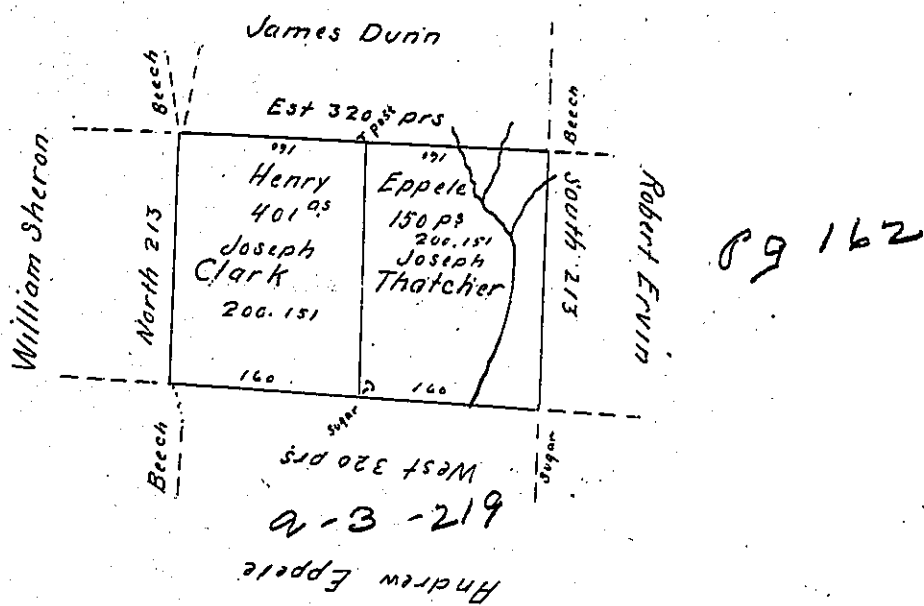

In pursuance of a warrant of 400<sup>as</sup> granted to Henry Eppeler bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792 for It being the same tract of Land which was Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1794 for William Dunn on his Improvement dated 5<sup>th</sup> November 1794.
