



A Draught of Mud Island situate in the river Susquehanna in Manor Township in the County of Lancaster Called Mud Island opposite to the lands of Patience Wright on the York County shore about two hundred perches to the westward of Garden Island at the lower end of Murpheys Hollow and about twenty perches above Rock Island. Containing two Acres & one hundred & twenty four perches Strict Measure Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1811 granted to Charles Evans.
