



A Draught of a Tract of land Situate in Germany Township in The County of York Surveyed by the Old Lines the 5th day of November 1792 to John Eckart in Pursuance of a Grant to Conrad Eckart dated the 21st day of February 1733/4 Containing Eighty Two Acres and one Hundred and forty Nine perches and Allowance of Six Acres p. Ct for Roads.

N.B. that part where the letter A. Stands is disputed by Martin and Daniel Miller But on Comparing a Draught of George Adam Cook found in the Papers of Thomas Armor Deceased I find that the line B. D. is the Original line of George Adam Cooks Survey.
