



In pursuance of a Warrant of 400 acres granted to John Evans dated the 30th day of May 1792. Was Surveyed on the 16th day of February 1830 for the heirs of Moses Cantfield deceased, the above described tract of land, containing 361 acres 112 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for Roads &c. and that John M. Tuller was resident on the same as tenant to the said heirs and there appeared upwards of 20 acres, cleared, fenced, & in a state of cultivation. Situate in Sadsbury township Crawford County Pennsylvania.
