



A Draught of a Piece of Land Situate in Windsor Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 154<sup>ac</sup> 20 prs. and allowances &c. Which was Originally Surveyed on the 4<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1772. for Frederick Frey, in pursuance of a Warrant for 50<sup>ac</sup> granted to William Dauglass, dated the 1<sup>st</sup> April 1751, And on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 1812. Returned the same by Jacob Spangler, then D.S.

And now on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June A.D. 1864 Draughted the above, and as the Official works of Jacob Spangler late D.S. being requested of P. A. & S. Small, the present Owners, who wish to Patent the same &c.
