



Situate in Dover Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 123° & 87 perches and the usual allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 197 1/2° and allowance of Land which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. on the 16th Day of November A.D. 1765, In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Valentine Flohr bearing date the 21st day of August A.D. 1765, Resurveyed by the old Lines and divided off from the said larger tract of Land on the 6th Day of December A.D. 1816 for and at the Request of Baltzer Hunkle who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
