E. branch of the River Susquehanna above Alex^r Speers, in the County of Northumberland, Survey'd for Mathias Graff on the fourth day of May 1774 by W^m Gray and resurvey'd by me on the 13th day of December 1784 by virtue of his Warrant bearing date the 26th day of October 1773. Containing One Hundred and Sixty four Acres and 155 Perches with the allowance of Six & Ct for Roads &c.
