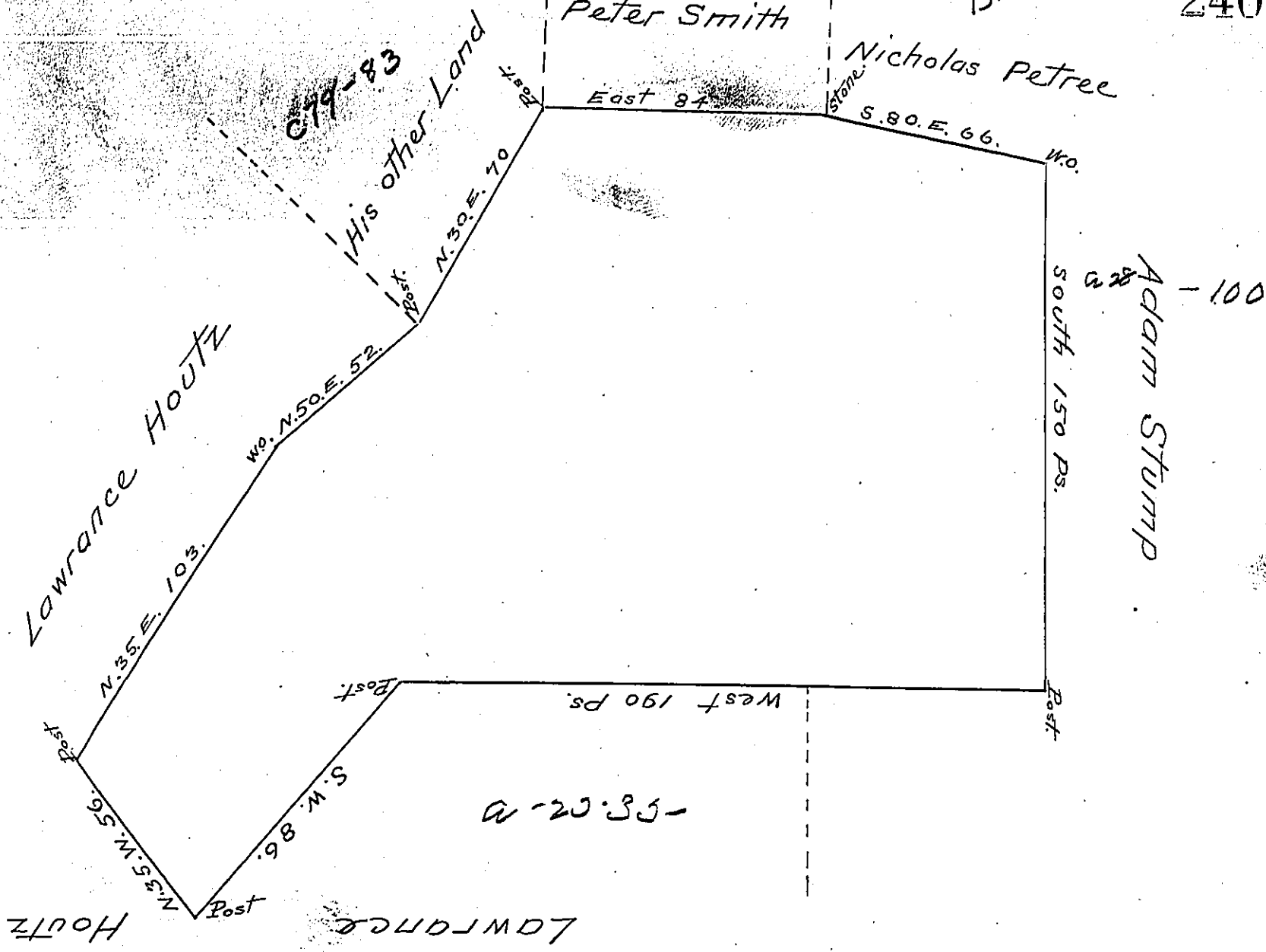

 of Land Besides the allowance of six &
 Cent Jasper Scull

March 31st 1791.

 Tract of Land D. B.
