



A Draught of a Peice of Land Situated in Southampton Townshih Franklin County (late Lurgan Township Cumberland County) Containing Forty five acres and Ninety five perches and Allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads & C. being part of a Tract of Seventy One acres formerly Surveyed to Robert Chamber's in persuance of an Order of Survey Dated August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1766 N<sup>o</sup> 714. Surveyed and laid off from the Part of Said Tract the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1791 by Mathew Henderson Esq<sup>r</sup> formerly Dep<sup>t</sup> Surveyor, as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in this office.
