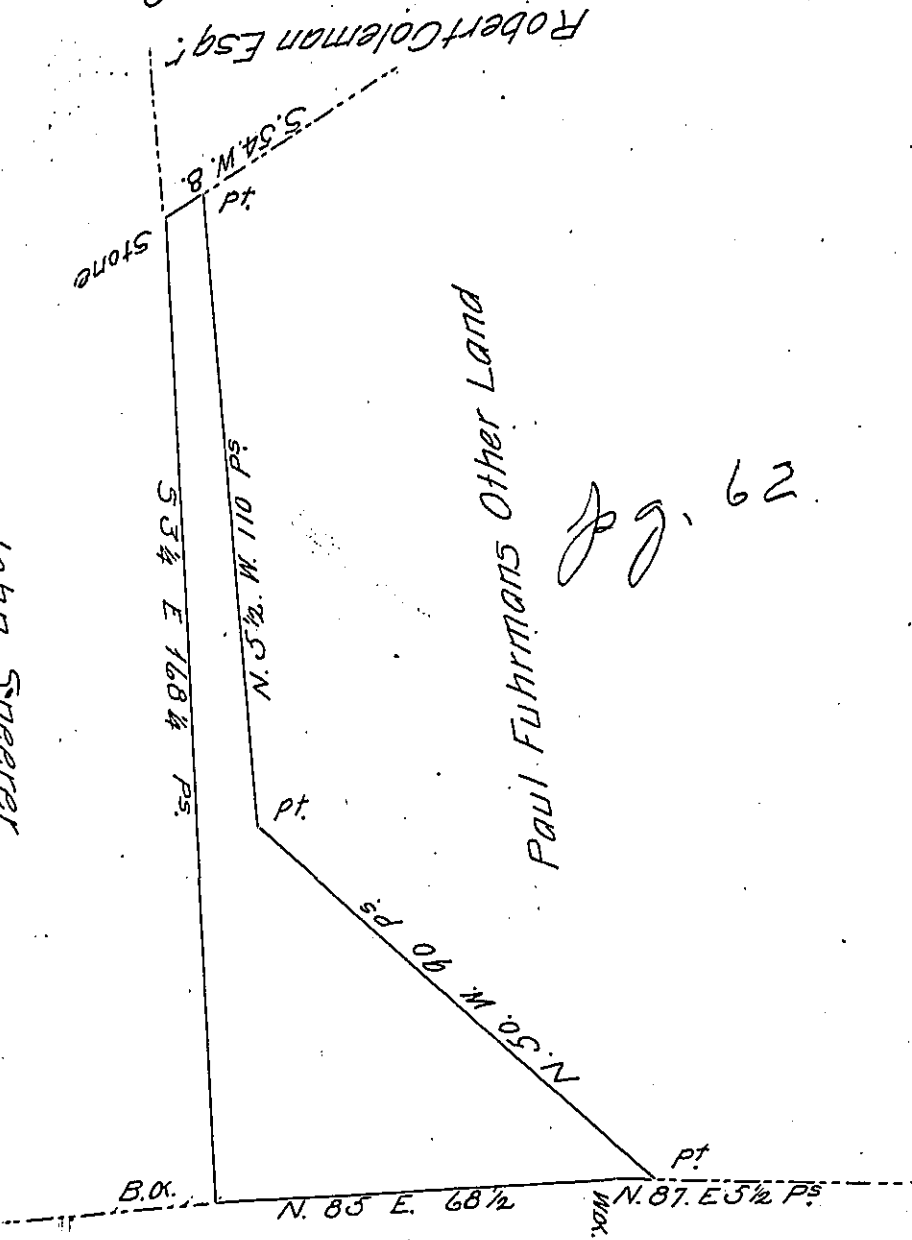

D. 1797 for Paul Fuhrman By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the Sixth Day of April A. D. 1757. N. B. about 11<sup>ac</sup> & 134 Ps & Allowance is included in the above Draught Which has been heretofore Surveyed by Mr. John Scull by Virtue of the above Mentioned Warrant and as the Remainder of s<sup>d</sup> Land for which the s<sup>d</sup> W<sup>t</sup> Called was left out either through Mistake or neglect, I was Directed by Special Orders of the Surveyor General To Survey & make Return of the Whole of s<sup>d</sup> Land unto the Surveyor Generals Office & C<sup>d</sup>
