Cent for roads &c. Situate in Mountpleasant Township in the County of Westmoreland

N.B. the above describ'd Tract of Land includes an improvement apparently first Commenc'd in the Spring of 1800. Samuel Gorgas & family was actually residing thereon at the time of Surveying the Same.
