In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>0</sup> dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June Anno Domini 1762. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1794. And now at the request of Dewalt Snider Guardian over the <sup>Person & Estate of Ge<sup>o</sup>. Gingrich a minor</sup> I am desired to make return of the draught as Calculated examined & ε the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Domini 1809.
