



Situate in Susquehanna Township Cambria County Lying on the West Branch of the Susquehanna about $3\frac{1}{4}$ Miles above the Cherry Tree. Containing three hundred forty two acres one hundred & forty six perches & the usual allowance of 6 P. Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 8th day of August 1838 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to George Fell dated the 18th Day of December 1793 for 400 acres
