Containing Seventy seven Acres one hundred and fifteen perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for Peter Wert, Thomas Weiss, Reuben Kern, Lewis Roth, Eli Mosser, School Board, John E Lintz, Thomas Jones, Widow John Dorward and John Fegelly the 7th day of June 1870, being a part of a larger tract of one hundred and fourteen acres and Sixty two Perches and allowance; originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Loenard Foor dated the 30th day of October 1745.
