



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Thicteenth day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Joseph Groves a tract of Land situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a. Begining at a Black Oak a Corner of his other Land thence by the Same North West Eighty two perches to a White Oak thence by land of Hans Siver North East Eighty three perches to a post. thence by land of Jacob Hubbaugh South East Eighty two perches to a post. thence by land of Frederick Rymer South West Eighty three perches to the place of Begining Containing forty Acres with the Usual Allowance of Six p. Cent
