



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the West Side of the River Sasquahannah in Hellam Township in the County of York late Part of the County of Lancaster (being Part of the Mannor of Springsbury) containing two hundred and thirty <sup>eight</sup> ~~six~~ Acres and the Allowance of Six Acres p. Cent for Roads and Highways. Surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September 1753 for Peter Gardner in Pursuance of a Grant under the Hand of the Honourable Thomas Penn. Esquire one of the Proprietaries of the Province of Pennsylvania bearing Date at Lancaster County October the 30<sup>th</sup> 1736.
