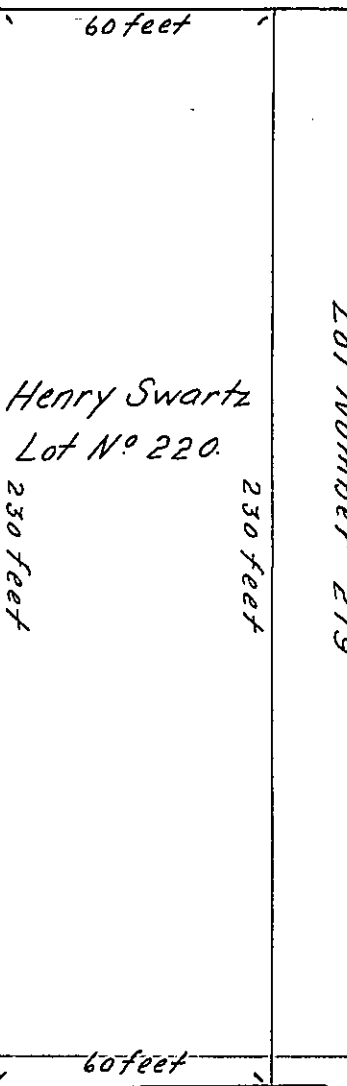

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Henry Swartz on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in Northumberland County. Containing in Breadth East & West Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Northward by Paakberry Street. Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Nineteen. Southward by Raspberry ~~Street~~ Alley and Westward by Deer Street. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1776 for Philip Gerhart.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty eighth day of October 1904
