



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 7th day of May 1747 I have surveyed to the Heirs of George Gleave a Lot of Ground (appurtenant to the said Gleave's original Purchase of 125 acres) Situate in the City of Philad^a between Spruce Street and Walnut Street and between the Fifth and Sixth Streets from Delaware. Containing in Breadth North and South Twenty four feet nine inches and ~~in~~ in Length one hundred and ninety eight feet Bounded Eastward with the said Fifth Street. Southward with William Moode's Lot Westward and Northward with Vacant Ground. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 30th day of June Anno Dom. 1752.
