



Surveyed on the Twenty Seveth day of March 1732 To Ulrick Boidler a Tract of Land Situate on a Branch of Perkiomie - Near Newcowissahoppin. Begining at a white Oak Saplin a Corner of his other land thence by land of Jacob Stover North West Eighty five perches to a post thence by land laid out for Henry Stover North East fifty four perches & by Vacant land the Same Course by Vacant land Forty Six perches to a post thence by Vacant land South East Eighty five perches to a post in the line of ye s^d Ulrick Boidler's other land Thence by the Same South West one hundred perches to ye place of Begining Containing Fifty Acres with Usual Allowance.
