



Situate in Washington (formerly Reading) Township York County Containing Sixteen Acres One hundred and nineteen perches & allowance of Six per cent. Surveyed 8th April 1767 by Charles Lukens Esq then D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 25⁰⁰ granted to Detrick Fahnestock, dated 20th May 1766. Resurveyed by the old lines the 8th of January 1824 (in consequence of a mistake having been made by M^r Lukens in chaining the side next the creek.) and returned at the request of Benjamin Harlocker present owner.
