



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Spring Grove, situated on Beaver meadow Run; Beginning at a marked Hickory standing about 90 P East from that part of the Old Road, leading from Kickeny pawlings Old Town to Fort Pitt, where the said Road Crosses the two Mile Spring below the Clear-fields; adjoining Land of Samuel Fisher and Stephen Carmick in Cumberland County; Containing Two hundred and Seventy three Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 18th of September 1770 for William Fisher of the City of Philadelphia, by Virtue of a Warrant granted to him, the 2<sup>d</sup> day of July in the year aforesaid
