A Draught of a tract of land situate in Millford township in Mifflin county, (formerly in Cumberland County ~~county~~) situate including a roaring spring surveyed ——— 1767 in pursuance of an order of survey to Samuel Brown dated 19<sup>th</sup> August 1766 No. 890 said to contain 141<sup>o</sup> & 48<sup>-</sup>perches with 6 P<sup>r</sup> Cent. Examined 2<sup>nd</sup> March 1814 and found to contain one hundred and forty one acres and seventy perches with 6 P<sup>r</sup> Cent. Note the day, nor month on which the original survey was made is not noted on the original draught, which remains in my office.
