

The draught of a tract of land situate in Brush Valley, Miles township Centre County (formerly Haines Township Northumberland County) containing two hundred and forty acres, sixty perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c ? Surveyed the 14th day of February 1810 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Paul Engle dated the 24th day of November 1773, and at the request of Joseph Miles Esq! a second return is made leaving out the interferance with Joseph Woods survey as appears by the doted lines at the easterly end of the draught.
