



Situate in Warrington Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 31<sup>9</sup> & 68 Perches. Being part of a larger tract of land of 139<sup>9</sup> & 94 Ps. and allowance of six per cent & c. which was surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1788 by John Forsyth late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Pugh bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October Anno Domini 1753. And afterwards resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land. And now at the request of the present owner Thomas Edmundson the above has been calculated examined & c. the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1810, and returned for confirmation.
