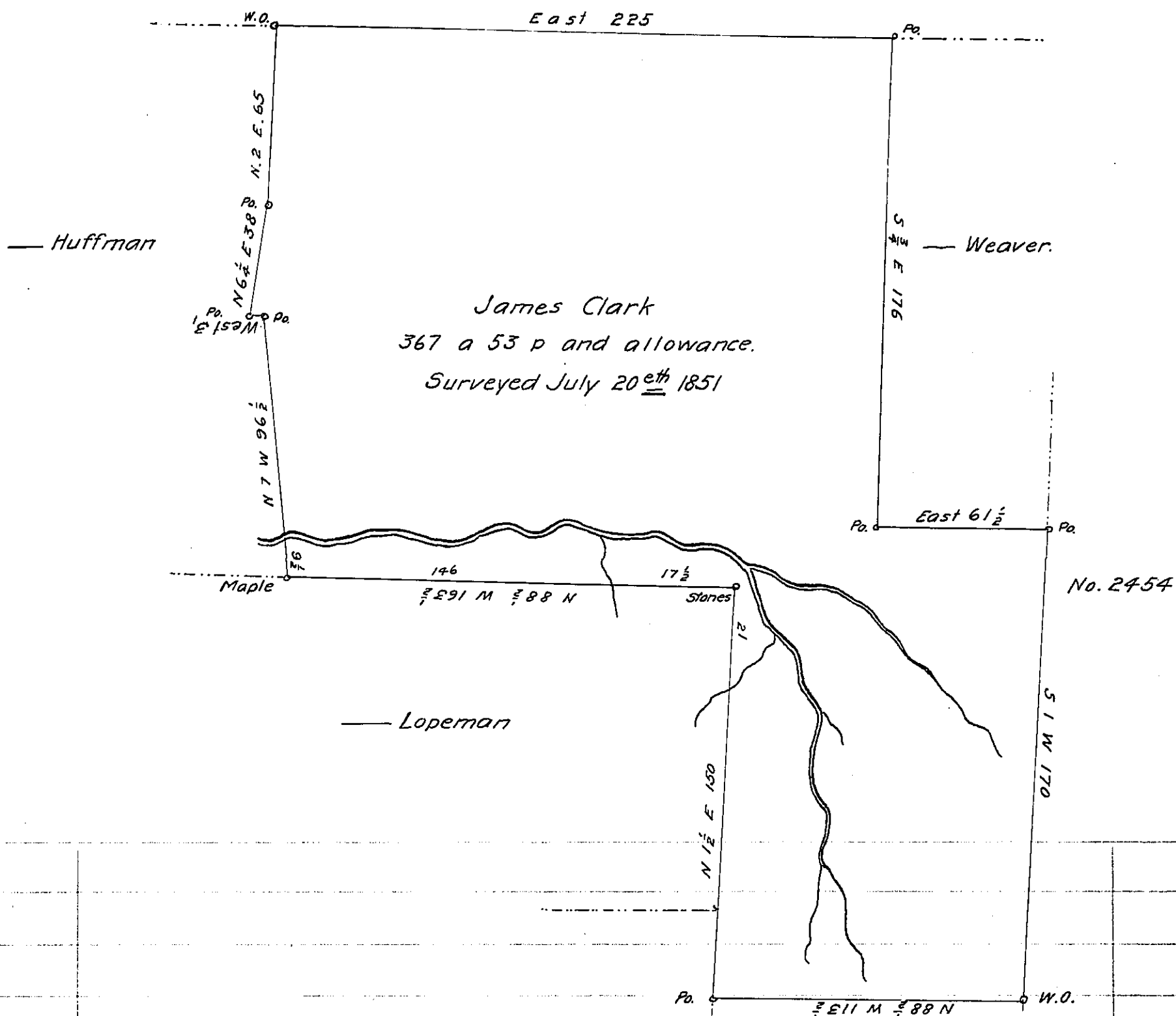


Warrant No. 2499 in name of Wilhem Willink



In pursuance of a warrant dated the fourteenth day of July A.D. 1851 granted to James Clark and directed to Matthew Riddle Esq. Surveyor for Venango County (The land therein described lying in my district) Surveyed to the aforesaid James Clark the above described tract of land situate in Richland Township Clarion (formerly Venango) County (Improved and settled since 1805) containing three hundred and sixty seven acres and fifty three perches and allowance of six per cent, on the 20th day of July A.D. 1851
